*All hammock models have been tested to hold at least 700 bs. However, never exceed the Comfort/Safety limit since it ensures the best weight to strength ratio.

**To be fully winterized, hammocks must have a WeatherShield (adds about 7.5 oz where optional) and the ability to receive Clark's Z-Liner underquilt system.

Notes:

All hammocks come with a wind-shedding Sil-Nylon rain tarp.

The tarp can be increased one size for \$20.00. It costs \$40.00 to increase the tarp size from Standard to Vertex.

Camouflaging both the hammock and rain tarp costs \$50.00. Adding camouflaging to only the rain tarp costs \$20.00.

Adding WeatherShield to TX, Tropical and Vertex models increases the price by \$40-\$55 depending on the model.

Never put more weight in the hammock than specified by the Comfort/Safety Weight Limit guideline.

If your height or weight is close to the Comfort/Safety limit, you should consider purchasing the larger size, if available.

This number guarantees both comfort and safety based on the strength of the hammock

* The TX-250 and TX-150 must have the WeatherShield option to be winterized.
